- Guide the participant in connecting to local community resources and aid them in accessing resources
- Follow-up with participants to ensure successful connection with resources

- Facilitate group sessions on various topics to guide participants toward their employment and financial goals
 using current Agency curricula, processes and procedures; and process related documents
