

LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER

A Licensed Clinical Social Worker is needed in our General Counseling Program to perform initial assessments with new clients who are referred to the department for counseling services and provide ongoing counseling services to clients with a variety of emotional difficulties and mental illnesses. Crisis intervention, facilitating groups, and case management are also part of the duties of the Clinical Counselor/Therapist. Record-keeping is both written and computerized and includes case notes, assessments, and evaluations.
