- Travel throughout Tarrant County to provide trainings to various schools
- Collect statistical data and input it, accurately and timely, into an online system
- Attend required staff meetings
- Maintain relationships with school staff and personnel
- Promote The Women's Center's mission through professional actions and words

Education and Experience Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree or 2 years experience in public speaking or training
- Ability to connect with school-aged children
- Minimum 3-day commitment per week, with ability to work full school day
- Strong communication, interpersonal, problem-solving, and organizational skills
- Ability to balance working independently and with a team, collect, and input data
- Ability to function in a non-profit setting focused on ending sexual assault
- Spanish-speaking reading and speaking fluency required
